Acknowledgment of Traditional Territories

The Town of St. Marys acknowledges that it is located on the traditional territory of the Haudenosaunee, Anishinaabe, and Ojibway/Chippewa peoples. This area is within the boundaries covered by Treaty 29, known as the Huron Tract Purchase, and is protected by the Dish With One Spoon wampum agreement. Today, many Indigenous peoples continue to call this land home and act as its stewards, and we are grateful to have the opportunity to live and work on this territory.

A stroll through historic downtown St. Marys is a must. The locally quarried limestone architecture tells stories of the past. Visitors can explore charming shops, meet friendly merchants, and perhaps find unique souvenirs to take home.

Foodies will be delighted by the dining options. From cozy pubs to restaurants, diners, and cafes, St. Marys offers locally-produced food and drink. Don't miss the chance to savor the flavors of the region.

Outdoor Adventures:

Pick up one of our Town trail maps and explore St. Marys on foot or by bike. There are many scenic spots along the route.

Hospitality and History:

The warm hospitality of St. Marys residents makes every visitor feel welcome. Immerse yourself in the town's history, chat with locals, and create lasting memories.

Discover St. Marys: A Journey Through History and Charm

The first European settlers arrived in St. Marys in the early 1840s, attracted by the area's natural resources. At the new town site, the Thames River cascaded over a series of limestone ledges, providing the power to run the first pioneer mills.

In the riverbed and along the banks, limestone was close to the surface and could be quarried for building materials.

St. Marys today retains its 19th century architecture while offering all the attractions of a modern and friendly small town. In the downtown, the streets are flanked with century-old buildings. Although the old mills have vanished, a community walkway follows the old millrace along the river. The architecture is what gives St. Marys its nickname: Stonetown.

Limestone is no longer quarried for building blocks but it is still essential to production at the St. Marys Cement Company. A limestone quarry abandoned in 1930 is now a popular municipal swimming destination and is known as Canada's largest natural swimming pool. Today the Quarry offers modern amenities and adventure for all ages with the addition of the Super Splash fun park, a large water trampoline and leisure swimming. It's fun for the whole

family!

Experience the charm and history of St. Marys by foot with three historic self-guided walking tours.

The Downtown Heritage Tour is perfect for those who want to explore the heart of St. Marys. You'll see beautifully restored Victorian-era retail spaces, stunning limestone architecture, and learn about the town's rich history including the building that housed both Timothy and Robert Eaton's businesses.

South Ward Tour takes you on a scenic journey through the history and natural beauty of St. Marys. You'll explore Lind Park, admire the Gothic Revival-style St. James Anglican Church, discover the town's rich history at the St. Marys Museum, and visit the Quarry for a dip.

North Ward Tour takes you through the charming residential neighbourhoods of St. Marys, where you'll discover local landmarks that tell the story of the town's heritage and explore the natural beauty of the Grand Trunk Trail.

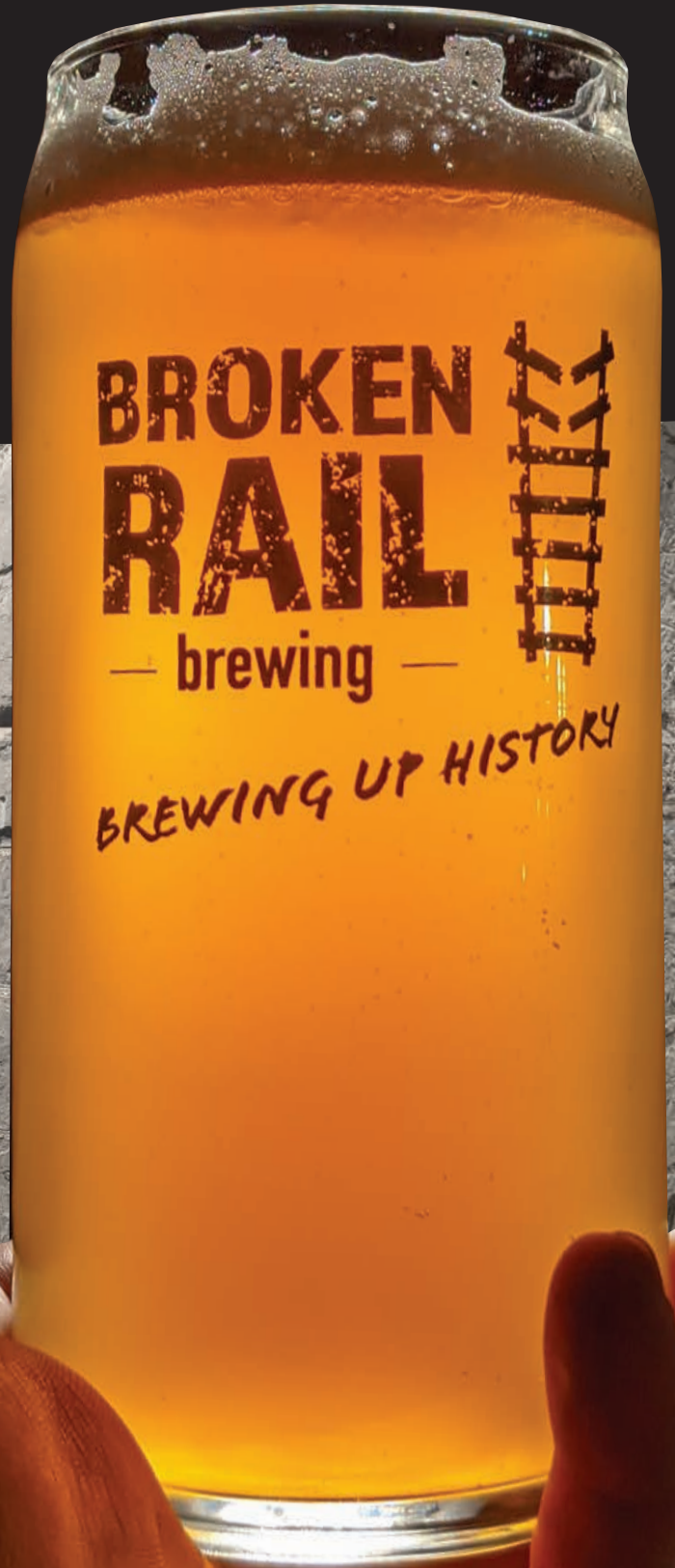

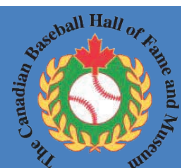

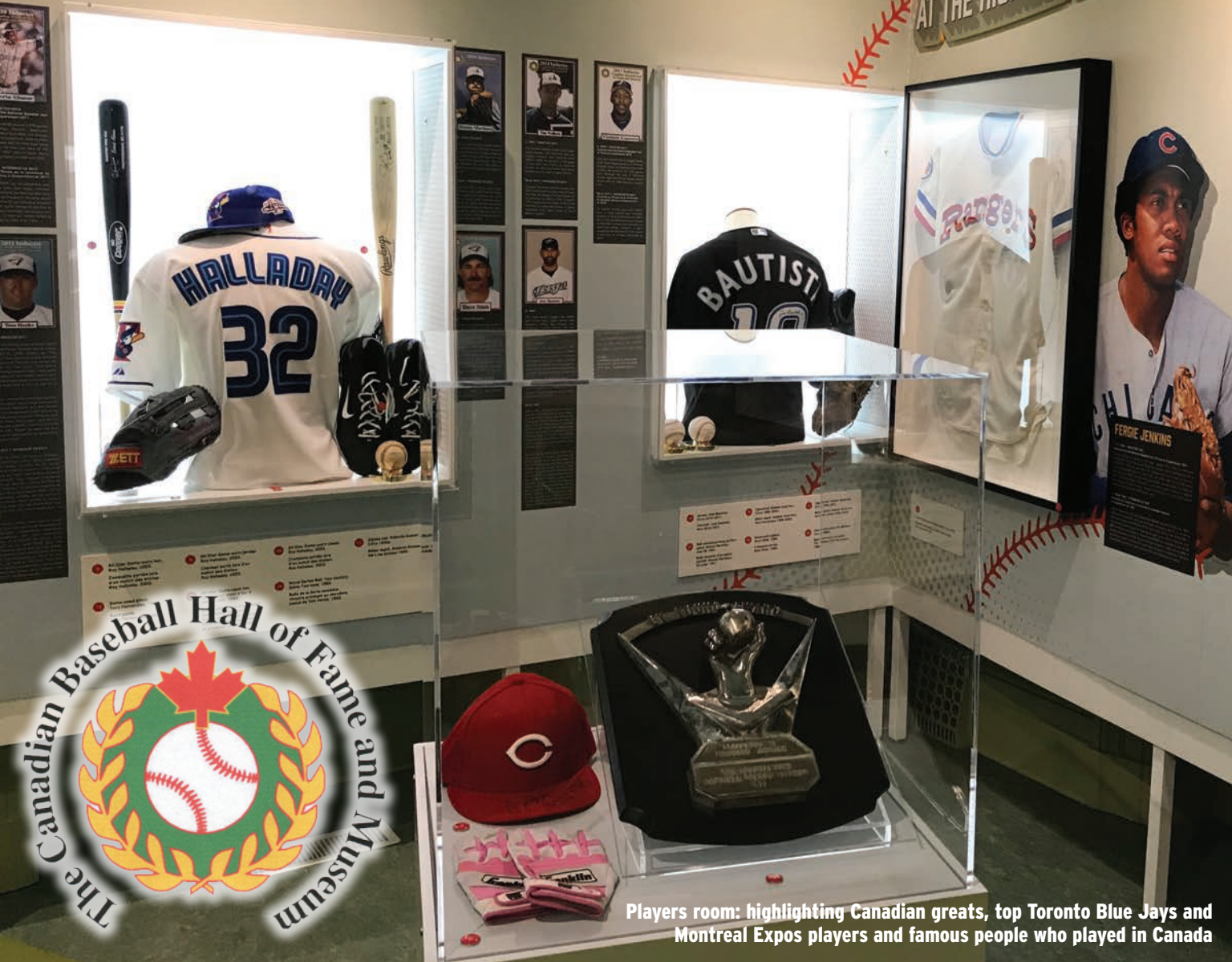

Celebrate April National Poetry Month with a stroll down Queen Street, and read inspiring poems in the downtown store windows, specially curated by the St. Marys Poetry Circle, which meets monthly in Barista's, 14 Water St. S.

Capturing Moments: The Art of Photography, experience the artistry of local photographers through St. Marys Clicks, a vibrant photography group. Enjoy the passion of **Community Theatre** with spring and fall productions by the St. Marys Community Players, attracting the talents of local residents in all areas of production. Musical Harmony: Local Talent Shines, experience musical performances that enrich daily life in St. Marys. Whether it's an intimate concert at the Town Hall Auditorium, an open-air festival, or live music accompanying your Saturday morning coffee or meal on a restaurant patio, let the melodies of

local and nationally known musicians captivate you.

You may find yourself in a film shoot produced by the local talents of **The Akoopfilm Company**. St. Marys is the backdrop for award-winning dramas. The St. Marys Train Station and Water Street (downtown) were used as filming locations in the hit show 'Murdoch Mysteries'.

Art and architecture have always been natural bedfellows. Artists at work in historical communities are signs that a town is viable, vibrant, and worth preserving. St. Marys is such a town - an Arts Town! It offers a wealth of cultural and heritage experiences so don't miss out visiting some of the sites, stores or interacting with some interesting artists.

The St. Marys historical train station is the home to the **Station Gallery** under the curation of Cameron Porteous (former Head of Design at Shaw Festival). The gallery hosts more than seven exhibits a year and showcases artists working across a wide spectrum of media in their gift shop.

The Art of Ideas Gallery is a private historical home built in 1881 that offers guided tours on Saturday, Sunday, and Mondays, as well as private tours that can be arranged for other days of the week (conditions apply). Meet visual artist Eugen-Florin Zamfirescu or attend a concert or art event that unite music and visual arts in the wonderfully glorious setting that is Art of Ideas.

St. Marys Museum and Archives is housed inside a 19th-century heritage home. Explore a wide range of exhibits and over 3,000 historic photographs and learn about the local history that shaped this beautiful town.

Stonetown Arts is a community group for artists & creative people that show the diversity of talent within the Arts community of St. Marys. Visit their Facebook page for dates and locations on their shows.

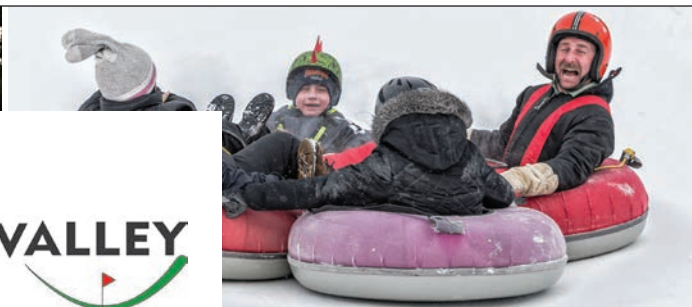
St. Marys and area offers three unique, picturesque and challenging golf courses to intrigue players of all abilities.

The St. Marys Golf & Country Club, founded in 1931, is a par-72 that stretches out to 6,567 yards from the back tees. "Located along the beautiful Thames River, the course prides itself on its spectacular views highlighted by incredible rolling hills, natural creeks and mature trees. The challenging, yet forgiving, course layout welcomes all types of players, from beginners to avid golfers," says Brandon De Groot, Director of Golf Operations. The Club also offers a first-class restaurant, Social Thirty-One, and an inviting patio. Weddings are often held on the picturesque grounds with receptions in one of the facilities' banquet halls.

Science Hill Country Club, opened in 1976, and remains one of Southwestern Ontario's best-kept secrets. Located in the countryside just a few minutes northwest of St. Marys on Road 137, Science Hill is a par-70

course measuring 5,900 yards from the tips. Last year, new ownership undertook many changes, including Taps On The Thames restaurant being the latest update to the clubhouse. From lunch, casual dining, live entertainment on the patio, or special occasion bookings, Taps has it all. Call for reservations or come in and enjoy one of the nicest patios in the area.

Just a short drive from St. Marys, River Valley Golf & Country Club is located on a very scenic and undulating parcel of land which is popular for all seasons - in the warm months as a golf course and in the winter months as a tube slide venue. Co-owner/operator David Tkachuk says of the par-65, 4,734 yard course, "The rolling hills and valleys offer beautiful views of the surrounding landscape. The golf course has lots of elevation that will challenge all playing levels." River Valley has a new Grand Hall for banquets, a restaurant, and spacious outdoor deck area.

Stonetown Eats and Drinks

Local food and drink is a great way to get acquainted with St. Marys - with the bonus of being delicious!

- **Coffee shops and bakeries:** enjoy a cup of your caffeine of choice with roasted-in-St. Marys beans at Snapping Turtle Coffee Roasters or sample the made-in-St. Marys treats paired with experienced baristas at Barista's. Craving comfort foods? Green Haven features daily fresh traditional baking (think fry pies and donuts), while Tim Horton's offers its classic favourites.
- **Pub life:** Gilly's Pubhouse on Water Street pairs bar classics with lots of screens to enjoy the big game, while O'Leary's Creamery offers a great view of the Thames from its patio with a classic menu.
- **Diner delights:** The Sunset Diner on the west end of Queen Street is a fun and funky 50s-style diner (their milkshakes are a must-try!). In the east end of town, Joe's Diner offers daily specials and all-day breakfast.
- **Casual but elevated:** in the downtown, Tutt Co Queen Street Eatery is FeastOn certified for its scrumptious use of local ingredients in food and drink. Social Thirty One, housed at the St. Marys Golf & Country Club, combines killer course views with a broad, craft- and local-based menu. The Westover Inn's seasonal dining wows with classic cuisine and bucolic patio. Naina's Indian Cuisine in the downtown offers authentically delicious dishes.
- **On the go:** Towne & Country Cheese Shoppe builds beautiful sandwiches and other takeaway treats, while Campbell's Canteen recreates food-truck favourites with sophistication. 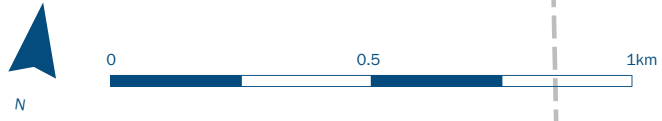

This limestone house was built in 1854 for George Tracy, one of the area's earliest settlers. At the time it was built it was by far the largest home in the small village, and almost immediately was nicknamed the "Castle in the Bush." It has been the location for the St. Marys Museum since 1959. Visitors are welcome throughout the year. They will see exhibits and materials on local history and can also explore the interior of the house itself. The St. Marys Museum has ten display areas open to the public, all containing artifacts associated with the history of this area. 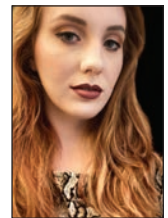

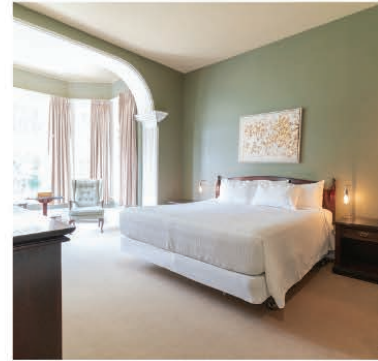
