Acknowledgment of Traditional Territories

The Town of St. Marys acknowledges that it is located on the traditional territory of the Haudenosaunee, Anishinaabe, and Ojibway/Chippewa peoples. The warm hospitality of St. Marys residents makes every visitor feel welcome. Immerse yourself in the town's history, chat with locals, and create lasting memories.

Discover St. Marys: A Journey Through History and Charm

The first European settlers arrived in St. Marys in the early 1840s, attracted by the area's natural resources. At the new town site, the Thames River cascaded over a series of limestone ledges, providing the power to run the first pioneer mills.

In the riverbed and along the banks, limestone was close to the surface and could be guarried for building materials.

St. Marys today retains its 19th century architecture while offering all the attractions of a modern and friendly small town. In the downtown, the streets are flanked with century-old buildings. Although the old mills have vanished, a community walkway follows the old millrace along the river. The architecture is what gives St. Marys its nickname: Stonetown.

Limestone is no longer quarried for building blocks but it is still essential to production at the St. Marys Cement Company. A limestone quarry abandoned in 1930 is now a popular municipal swimming destination and is known as Canada's largest natural swimming pool. Today the Quarry offers modern amenities and adventure for all ages with the addition of the Super Splash fun park, a large water trampoline and leisure swimming. It's fun for the whole

family

Experience the charm and history of St. Marys by foot with three historic self-quided walking tours.

The Downtown Heritage Tour is perfect for those who want to explore the heart of St. Marys. You'll see beautifully restored Victorian-era retail spaces, stunning limestone architecture, and learn about the town's rich history including the building that housed both Timothy and Robert Eaton's businesses.

South Ward Tour takes you on a scenic journey through the history and natural beauty of St. Marys. You'll explore Lind Park, admire the Gothic Revival-style St. James Anglican Church, discover the town's rich history at the St. Marys Museum, and visit the Quarry for a dip.

North Ward Tour takes you through the charming residential neighbourhoods of St. Marys, where you'll discover local landmarks that tell the story of the town's heritage and explore the natural beauty of the Grand Trunk Trail.





local and nationally known musicians captivate you.

You may find yourself in a film shoot produced by the local talents of **The Akoolfilm Company.** St. Marys is the backdrop for award-winning dramas. The St. Marys Train Station and Water Street (downtown) were used as filming locations in the hit show 'Murdoch Mysteries'.

Art and architecture have always been natural bedfellows. Artists at work in historical communities are signs that a town is viable, vibrant, and worth preserving. St. Marys is such a town - an Arts Town! It offers a wealth of cultural and heritage experiences so don't miss out visiting some of the sites, stores or interacting with some interesting artists.

The St. Marys historical train station is the home to the **Station Gallery** under the curation of Cameron Porteous (former Head of Design at Shaw Festival). The gallery hosts more than seven exhibits a year and showcases artists working across a wide spectrum of media in their gift shop.

The Art of Ideas Gallery is a private historical home built in 1881 that offers guided tours on Saturday, Sunday, and Mondays, as well as private tours that can be arranged for other days of the week (conditions apply). Meet visual artist Eugen-Florin Zamfirescu or attend a concert or art event that unite music and visual arts in the wonderfully glorious setting that is Art of Ideas.

St. Marys Museum and Archives is housed inside a 19th-century heritage home. Explore a wide range of exhibits and over 3,000 historic photographs and learn about the local history that shaped this beautiful town.

Just a short drive from St. Marys, River Valley Golf & Country Club is located on a very scenic and undulating parcel of land which is popular for all seasons - in the warm months as a golf course and in the winter months as a tube slide venue. Co-owner/operator David Tkachuk says of the par-65, 4,734 yard course, "The rolling hills and valleys offer beautiful views of the surrounding landscape. 


This limestone house was built in 1854 for George Tracy, one of the area's earliest settlers. At the time it was built it was by far the largest home in the small village, and almost immediately was nicknamed the "Castle in the Bush." It has been the location for the St. Marys Museum since 1959. Visitors are welcome throughout the year. They will see exhibits and materials on local history and can also explore the interior of the house itself. The St. Marys Museum has ten display areas open to the public, all containing artifacts associated with the history of this area. Throughout the year, there is a schedule of changing exhibits and activities, based on the collection. There is always something new to see!
